Purpose:

The Tabor College cheer team is a group of selected individuals whose purposes are to represent Tabor College in a positive light and to perform and entertain audiences. It is an honor and a privilege to be a part of this organization.

The Tabor College cheer program is looking for well-rounded athletes with cheerleading skills and cheerleading ability. The TC cheer program realizes that not all potential cheer participants have advanced tumbling or advanced stunting skills. Be prepared to take direction and coaching during the tryout process. Do not assume that weakness or lack of skill in any one area will automatically disqualify you as a potential team member. A positive attitude and hard work ethic must be displayed at all times in order to be considered for this privilege.

Attitude

Attitudes and /or egos shall be left at the door. Any past accomplishments in cheer/dance/stunting or otherwise carry very little weight in the selection process. The TC coaching staff has the right to remove any participant at any time for bad attitude or failure to follow safety guidelines and regulations for stunting or general safety of the program.

Score/Judging Sheets

Scores and judging sheets will not be released. The coach and select experienced judges will make all final decisions on team member selection. Any tryout participant that has questions after the team is officially announced may ask questions before they leave the tryout facility.

Tryout Results:

Participants who made the final selection will be informed no later than Friday May 22, 2010. Once selections have been made scholarship amounts will also be announced. All people trying out will be fitted for a uniform, but this does not mean you have made the squad. You will not know whether or not you are on the squad until the 22nd.

Requirements for tryouts:

Tryouts consist of seven sections

1. Original Chant (you bring your own)
2. Cheer (this will be learned on site)
3. Dance (this will be learned on site)
4. Jumps (right herkie, left herkie, toe touch and optional jump)
5. Partner/quad stunts (everyone is required to display 2 different stunting positions)
6. Interview
7. Attitude/Work Ethic
