

Tabor College 3rd Annual 7 on 7 Passing Jamboree 09' Saturday June 20

The Tabor College 7 on 7 Passing Jamboree will allow participants to improve their individual and team skills in the passing game. *Participants entering grades 9 – 12 are eligible to participate in the 7 on 7 camp.* The Camp will be made up of 12 teams. Teams will consist of 10 – 12 players. Each team will play a minimum of 4 games. Schedules and format of play will be explained day of the camp.

When: Saturday June 20th. – Camp begins at 9:00 a.m. sharp – coach's mtg. at 8:30 a.m. sharp. Meeting will take place in the Tabor Football Offices in the located directly north of the Tabor Game field – White building.

Cost: \$ 150.00 per team (10 – 12) participants – \$20.00 for each additional participant

GAME SCHEDULE:

All games will begin and end at the same time. Games will consist of (2) 20 minute halves-running clock. Halftime will last 5 minutes. There will be 15 minute break prior to the start of next game.

Game 5 is optional between coaches.

7 on 7 Tabor Passing Jamboree rules:

Playing Field is 45 yards in length. A first down is gained every 15 yards. When the offense reaches the +30 yard line (1st down) and again when they reach the + 15 yard line (1st down). Change of possession if team does not convert on 3rd down. Ball will be moved back to starting point + 45 yard line. Defense can score on an interception – if they do not score they get ball on + 45. Q.B. has 4 seconds to throw ball. If ball is not gone it is a sack. Do not have to use center, but this does allow good reps for Q.B. center exchange. A player is down when touched two hands below the neck. There is no down field blocking.

T.D. = 6 points PAT= 2 points
