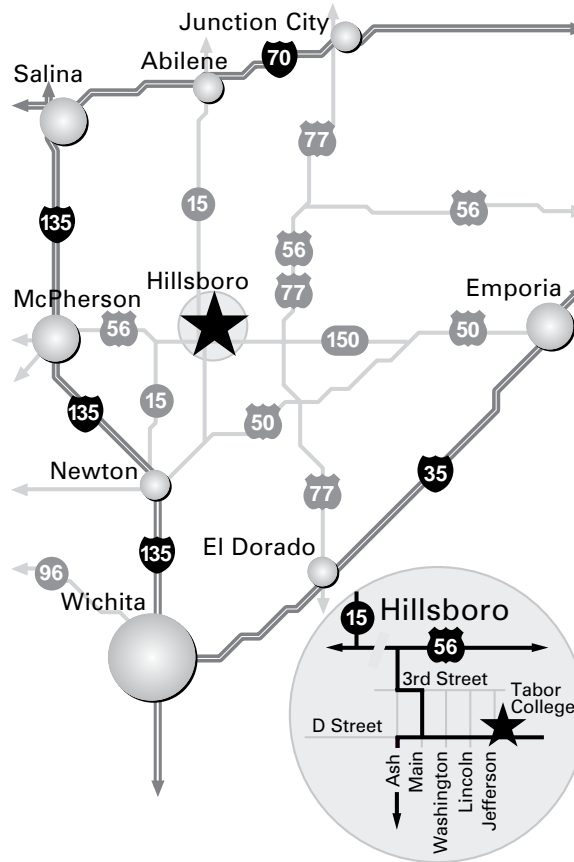

ABOUT CAMP
